Cristian Pascu is a software engineer and IT entrepreneur. He has graduated the Faculty of Physics of the University of Bucharest (2003), and obtained a master of Analytical Philosophy at the Faculty of Philosophy of the same university (2013). Cristian started working as a software engineer in 2004 and since then has been involved in a wide range of projects and technologies, from web and mobile applications to enterprise projects for multinational corporations such as Finsiel, Axway, and Avira. In 2009 he launched his own commercial product, a visual design tool for User Experience designers, which is now used by more than 2800 companies around the world, from small design agencies to large companies like Microsoft and Intel. He is a frequent speaker of tech events where he focuses on topics revolving around both creating natural human-computer interactions, and software programming design patterns.
